All PATH members are eligible for a drawing for prizes if they **carpooled, bicycled, walked, or rode transit at least 10 times** or about twice a week per month. If you have made at least 10 trips using any of these modes in January, simply reply to this email to be entered into the drawing.

PATH members who carpool or bike to work are also eligible for the **Emergency Ride Home benefit**. If you or or fellow carpooler gets caught without transportation in the event of an emergency, PATH will reimburse your cost of transportation home according to the rules of the program.
