If you have carpoled, bicycled, walked, or taken transit to work at least 10 times (or about twice per week) during the month of November you are eligible for the PATH monthly drawing for prizes. Simply reply to this email or email path@cnhrpc.org to report your commutes and be entered into the drawing.

As a PATH member you will receive this email once per month with news, stories, and event listings. If you prefer to not get the monthly email, you may unsubscribe at the bottom of the email.

PATH members who carpool or bike to work are also eligible for the Emergency Ride Home benefit. If you or your fellow carpooler gets caught without transportation in the event of an emergency, PATH will reimburse your cost of transportation home according to the rules of the program. As you may remember from last month's newsletter, Concord Area Transit (CAT) and the Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission (CNHRPC, the organization that hosts PATH) are taking a look at Concord's public bus service to see how service can be improved.



This first phase of the study involves public outreach and input from stakeholders. Critical to this effort is a survey of non-users and users alike.



Project Outline:

Public Outreach and Input from Stakeholders: Survey, public meetings, interviews and events

Analysis of Existing Service: Data collection, system-wide analysis, etc.

Draft Service Improvement Opportunities: Create a menu of service improvement ideas

Selection of Preferred Alternative/Service Recommendations: Public meetings, final service recommendations and improvement ideas and creation of transit service plan

Bicycle Master Plan Kickoff Meeting on Monday December 7

The City of Concord's Bicycle Subcommittee of the Transportation Policy Advisory Committee Bike (TPAC-Bike), PATH and the CNHRPC will be kicking off the City's Bicycle Master Planning Process on Monday, December 7th at 6:30pm in City Council Chambers.



This plan cannot be done without you!

TPAC-Bike and the CNHRPC is strongly encouraging bicyclists of all ages and ability levels and any other interested citizens to attend the meeting and future meetings. Topics will be discussed in six working groups. Topics will include: Creating a Bicycle Route Map; "Hot Spots;" End of Trip Facilities and Transit; Education, Encouragement and Safety; Policy Objectives; and Visioning and Goals.

The meeting will also introduce the public to what a Bicycle Master Plan is and will discuss what TPAC-Bike has done since it was formed, including an update on the North-South Bicycle Route that was proposed this September.

The Bicycle Master Plan will include the creation of maps for bicycle routes, trails, bike parking and facilities, educational and safety opportunities and the potential development of programs like bicycle facilities at workplaces and bicycle sharing programs.
